**TODAY'S GAME**: The Blowfish come out of the off day recharged and ready to take on the HiToms for the final time this summer. Parker Whittle gets his second start after going 3 scoreless as an opener a week ago at Macon.

**YESTERDAY'S NEWS:** Lexington County saw their six game win streak come to a close as they fell to the Bacon 8-5. Macon excelled at perfectly placed soft contact, dropping bloops and 3-hoppers right between defenders. The HiToms lost 4-2 to Forest City, allowing 2 in the bottom of the 8<sup>th</sup> after tying the game in the top half. They have now dropped 3 straight and 4 of 5, as well as 5 straight games on the road.

**FIRST HALF RECAP:** The Blowfish went 10-14 in the first half, tied for 5<sup>th</sup> in the Western Division. Savannah and Morehead City were the two division winners, and have clinched automatic bids to the playoffs. The Blowfish had 15 homers, led by Braylin Marine with 4, who also had the longest hit streak at 12 games and counting. Robbie Jordan and Carson Starnes have proved reliable starters as freshman, and Beau Ross has been electric out of the pen. Marine and Ryan Ouzts have been the big offensive weapons for Jonathan Johnson's sliding squad. Currently, Vradenburg leads the league in RBIs and walks (41 and 34).

**ROSTER REPORT:** The 2022 Blowfish feature a plethora of players returning from last year, including 1B Brock Vradenburg and RHP Josh Topper. They are joined by four players coming back for year 3 in Josh Hernandez, Crosby Jones, Jared Kirven, and Aaron White. In the constant turnover of the roster, players like Ouzts, Marine, and Mims who have been here since day one stand out. LHP Michael Watson just arrived, and could be a big impact arm immediately. Talmadge LeCroy, Wells Sykes, David Cromer, Ryan Brash, and Braylin Marine have left in the last few days.

**SELF-INFLICTED WOUNDS:** Lexington County continues to be snakebit by costly errors and walks, but the biggest issue has been wild pitches. The Blowfish walked 108 batters in 24 first half games, tossed 47 wild pitches, and committed 36 errors, led by Billy Amick with 10. They are 0-7 in one run games, and have a particular talent for saving their mistakes for the most crucial of times in the ballgame. This, combined with repeated struggles to score runs off of back-end relievers, have led to a series of soul-crushing losses to wrap up the first half. The Blowfish pitching walked 3 against Macon but could not overcome timely hitting.

**NICE TO SEE YOU AGAIN:** This is the 5<sup>th</sup> and final matchup between these two ballclubs, and the third here at the Lex. The Blowfish lost each of the first 3 meetings by 2 runs or less, before turning things around and knocking off the HiToms 14-5. The Blowies had 5 bombs in that game, headlined by 2 from Crosby Jones. Dalton Mims earned the win in that contest.

**NEXT TIME OUT:** Lexington County has games every day this week to finish out the season, assuming you include Friday's exhibition against the Purple Martins. Their final road trip of the summer comes tomorrow as they head to the Port City, traveling up to Wilmington to battle the Sharks after being walked off there in the only visit this season so far. Michael Watson makes his 5<sup>th</sup> and final start of the summer, which is also his first time facing the potent Sharks offense. The HiToms are next in CPL action on Thursday, traveling to McNair Field to try to avenge yesterday's loss to the Owls.
