
We have provided your school with the following materials:

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BLOWIE'S ALL-STAR READING PROGRAM TEACHER & LIBRARIAN CHECKLIST

- Display the poster in your classroom and write in the school's game date, once confirmed.
- Share the parent/guardian letter with each student in your classroom to ensure the expectations of the Reading Program are known as well as the school's game date and link to claim tickets.

BLOWIE'S ALL-STAR READING PROGRAM HOW IT WORKS...

- Students are challenged to read four (4) reading level appropriate, extra-curricular books during their school's Reading Program dates to receive rewards.
- Students are asked to track their Reading Program progress on the provided Reading Tracker.
- After reading four (4) books and 'hitting a home run', parents/guardians can visit the link (or QR Code) provided on the Reading Tracker to claim the student's rewards.
- Each student who reads four (4) books within the appropriate dates, will receive:
 - Two (2) complimentary tickets (seats will be determined based on availability by the Blowfish staff) to the school's assigned Blowfish game
 - Opportunity to participate in the Reading Program parade during the Blowfish game
 - One (1) Blowie Snowie shaved ice
- We ask that school's complete their Reading Program's by May 1 in order to provide our staff enough time to send out the requested tickets to students and facilitating educators.
- We prefer that all ticket requests are made no later than May 15, in order to ensure our staff has enough time to complete the requests.



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BLOWIE'S ALL-STAR READING PROGRAM PARENT/GUARDIAN LETTER

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Our class will be participating in Blowie's All-Star Reading Program, presented by the Lexington County Blowfish. Your student will have the opportunity to improve their reading skills while earning rewards from the the Blowfish, including two (2) complimentary tickets to a Blowfish game, a free Blowie Snowie Shaved Ice and the opportunity to participate in the Reading Program parade on the school's assigned game night.

In order to complete the Reading Program, you student needs to read four (4) age-appropriate books outside of the classroom before May 1, 2026.

After your student 'hits a home run' to complete the Reading Program, please either scan the QR code or visit the link listed on the Reading Program Tracker and fill out the form on the Blowfish website to claim your student's rewards.

Complimentary tickets will be issued by the Blowfish staff through its ticketing platform, Flickit. Parents/guardians may add on additional tickets for the price of \$6.50 each. In order to do this, parents/guardians must request the number of tickets on the online form at the end of the Reading Program.

We ask that you please fill out the online form to request tickets **at least one week prior to your school's assigned game night** in order to provide enough time for the Blowfish staff to complete your request. Please bring your Reading Tracker to the concession stand on your game night to redeem for the Blowie Snowie Shaved Ice.

Additionally, you may bring your Reading Tracker to the Box Office on the night of the game to redeem for two (2) complimentary General Admission tickets if you miss the deadline.


